Subject: California Delegation Information for the 2008 IACP Conference

The 2008 Annual IACP Conference will be held in San Diego November 8-12. **This year, the California delegation will be staying at the Sheraton San Diego Hotel & Marina**, which is located at 1380 Harbor Island Drive, San Diego, 92101. A block of 200 rooms has been set aside for CPCA members. The room rates are \$229 single and \$249 double, and the hotel room tax is 12.565 percent. **If you want to stay at the Sheraton Hotel & Marina with the California Delegation, please fill out the provided housing form and send it to the CPCA office in Sacramento along with your credit card guarantee no later than August 15th.** The rooms are available on a first come, first served basis and the block may be gone before August 15th. All present and future housing reservations or changes must be made through Cal Chiefs, not IACP or the Sheraton.

San Diego is a great venue and our hotel is right on the San Diego Bay. This is an important conference for Cal Chiefs because Craig Steckler, our past president and Communications/Membership Chair, is running for election as IACP 4th Vice President. Craig kicked off his campaign at last year's IACP Conference and has spent the last several months traveling to almost every state and speaking to other police chief associations. It's important for California to have a strong voice within IACP leadership and Craig can provide that. We are counting on many Cal Chiefs' members to volunteer in San Diego to help assist with the campaign. We will be holding a reception for Craig on Sunday evening as a campaign kick-off. Our goal is to have as many of our members (and IACP members) attend the conference and vote on either Monday or Tuesday, November 10-11. Our legendary hospitality suite will be back, hosted again by US Armor. Chiefs are also encouraged to send their second-in-commands to the conference and trade show.
