



# Police Lieutenant – 2 positions

Salary: **Up to \$129,800 Annual Salary**

**Benefits:**

- Several medical plans offered; dental & vision paid for by the University
- \$50,000 life insurance is provided; additional coverage may be purchased up to 4x annual salary rate
- \$725/year uniform allowance; all leather gear and firearms issued by Department
- University system-wide transfer and promotional opportunities available

**Leaves:**

- 13 paid holidays
- At least 3 weeks vacation/year with increases based on years of service
- 12 sick days per year with UNLIMITED accrual

**Retirement:**

- Automatic vesting after 5 years of service in the UC Retirement Plan; 3% at 50 with non-contributory status by employee. (PERS reciprocity and limited reciprocity available-see [www.calpers.ca.gov](http://www.calpers.ca.gov) for eligibility requirements)
- 100% of sick leave converted to service credit upon retirement
- 50% of health plan paid by UC with just 10 years of service and up to 100% contribution with 20 years of service for employee and eligible family members

**UC Tuition:**

- Eligible employees pay only 1/3 of tuition fees at any UC campus

**DESCRIPTION:**

Under the general direction of the Chief of Police or a Police Captain, a Police Lieutenant provides command level management to a division or unit within the Department. The Lieutenant is responsible for planning, directing, and managing the assigned activities of a division or unit of the department and performing other duties as assigned.

**REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

Note: Medical examination, psychological evaluation, fingerprinting and background check and a Valid California Drivers License required

- Eligible internal University of California Police Department Police Sergeants with at least 2 years of UCPD service at that rank or currently employed as a UCPD Police Lieutenant.
- Eligible candidates who are outside the University of California must be currently employed as a Police Lieutenant or be at the rank of Police Sergeant for at least 5 years.
- Must possess current California Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Advanced and Supervisory certificates.
- Working knowledge of state of the art police and security management methods, philosophies, law enforcement practices and legal issues; technical knowledge of computerized systems which support the wide variety of applications used in the law enforcement and business professions.
