<b>Costa Mesa</b>	(714) 754-5245	Kimberly Brant	Ordinance prohibits medical marijuana dispensaries (MMD).	Very little public comment; one against the ordinance and the remainder spoke in favor of prohibiting MMDs.	
<b>Cypress</b>	(714) 229-6720	Ted Commerdinger	Ordinance specifically defines and then prohibits MMDs in all zones of the City.	Testimony from approximately 12 persons; evenly split for and against the ordinance.	Approval of the ordinance by the Cypress City Council was a three to two vote.
<b>Fullerton</b>	(714) 738-6559	Bob St. Paul	Notice of intent to modify the zoning ordinance to prohibit the establishment of MMDs.	Approximately 6 persons attended the first PC meeting, but did not have the opportunity to speak due to the item being continued to 10/25. Mr. St. Paul received one letter for the ordinance and one letter against the ordinance.	Ordinance to prohibit MMD facilities is scheduled for PC review on 10-25-06 (continued from 9-27). <b>Huntington Beach</b>	(714) 536-5438	Herb Fauland	Adopted an ordinance to permit MMDs as a permitted use in the Industrial Zone.	Very little public input was received regarding the code amendment. Staff has since received one inquiry for a MMD.	The City Council lifted its moratorium after setting minimal distances that must separate dispensaries from churches, parks, and schools (500 feet) and other dispensaries (750 feet).
<b>Newport Beach</b>	(949) 644-3204	Robin Clawson (City Attorney's Office)	Interim urgency ordinance extending a temporary moratorium of MMD.	Very little input from the public; however, prior to approving the interim urgency ordinance, Staff received significant comments from a non-permitted MMD operating within their City's limits.	Last interim urgency ordinance approved April 25, 2006.

No public comment.	Staff indicated they seldom receive comments from the public at their City Council meetings. Ordinance was adopted on August 22, 2006.
<b>Tustin</b>	(714) 573-3100	Elizabeth Binsack	Interim urgency ordinance to prohibit the establishment of any medical marijuana dispensaries for a period of 10 months and 15 days.	Very little public input on the ordinance. The one exception was from the owners of a non-permitted MMD within their City.	Ordinance was adopted on March 20, 2006.
