Chapter 9.14 REGISTRATION OF GUESTS IN HOTELS, ETC.

9.14.010 Required—Information to be shown.

No person shall provide sleeping accommodations in any hotel, inn, motel, auto camp, public rooming or lodging house, or other similar place within the city, unless the person requesting such accommodation has filled out a register with at least the following information: date and time of registration; names and home addresses of all persons to be accommodated; the make, type and license number of any automobile, trailer or other vehicle, and the state in which such vehicle is or are registered, and the year of registration. 9.14.020 Register to be kept two years.

Such register shall be kept for a period of no less than two years by the person providing the accommodations as specified in Section 9.14.010 of this chapter. (Ord. 569-01 § 1 (part), 2001)

9.14.030 Inspection of register by law enforcement officers.

Any City Police Officer having reasonable suspicion of criminal activity involving any guest or room at a hotel/motel within the City shall be given prompt access to such register for the sole purpose of conducting such investigation. Furthermore, no City Police Officer shall inspect a hotel/motel register without first obtaining approval from a City Police Department supervisor. (Ord. 569-01 § 1 (part), 2001)

9.14.040 Fictitious registration.

No Person registering at any place as specified in Section 9.14.010 of this chapter shall register him or herself or any other person under any false or assumed name or designation, or under the name of any other person or fictitious person, and no person shall knowingly allow him or herself to be registered under any such false, fictitious or assumed name. No person placing any information required by Section 9.14.010 of this chapter in any register, shall falsely or inaccurately state such information. (Ord. 569-01 § 1 (part), 2001)
