They are currently in the process of trying to get a music/live entertainment permit, but they are located next to our largest hotel, so I am not sure how that will work out with the Planning Department.

We have a restaurant (Grapevine) which allows outdoor hookah smoking which was incorporated into their C.U.P. There was a more recent applicant who proposed a Hookah lounge with indoor smoking and sales of hookah paraphernalia. They were denied approval from the City and they never opened.
