**~2002 Anaheim Conference Workshop A Success~**

Forty retired police chiefs attended the 2002 annual conference of the California Police Chiefs Association at the Disneyland Hotel, in Anaheim, California, the largest turnout of retired members in history. During the conference, fifty participants attended the retired members' workshop, where we outlined the proposed agreement with Public Service Skills, Inc., after which Clark Goecker, Executive Director of PSS, answered questions and distributed the updated registration forms for those interested in being considered for either interim chiefs positions, consulting contracts, or both.

For those retired members who could not attend the conference, the new registration form is available to download at the end of this message. Even though you may already be registered with PSS for interim chief positions, PSS would like to update their records and is requesting that all retired member complete a new registration form. Doing this will permit retired members the opportunity to indicate an interest in one or the other of these expanded services contemplated by this new agreement.

These new registration forms should be completed and mailed to Clark Goecker, at Public Service Skills, Davis, California, with the requisite information called for in the form. PSS will allow approximately 30 days for receipt of these forms, and will then update its database. During this period, the retired members committee will work with PSS to develop a marketing plan so we may make known the availability of retired chiefs as independent consultants as outlined in the agreement. We hope to have the marketing plan in place and the information available to all interested agencies for implementation of these expanded services by early April 2002. Once implemented, we will report on the progress of this effort and evaluate the impact of this program at the February 2003 CPCA conference in Oakland, California.

In addition to the workshop, several retired members hosted an informal reception on the evening following the workshop, which was well attended, and where a number of retired members reacquainted themselves. Thanks to retired Chief Roger Scuitto, Saint Mary's College DPS, and Chief Jack Griggs, Delano PD, for providing the suite, refreshments, and snacks for this event, which we hope to repeat next year.
