



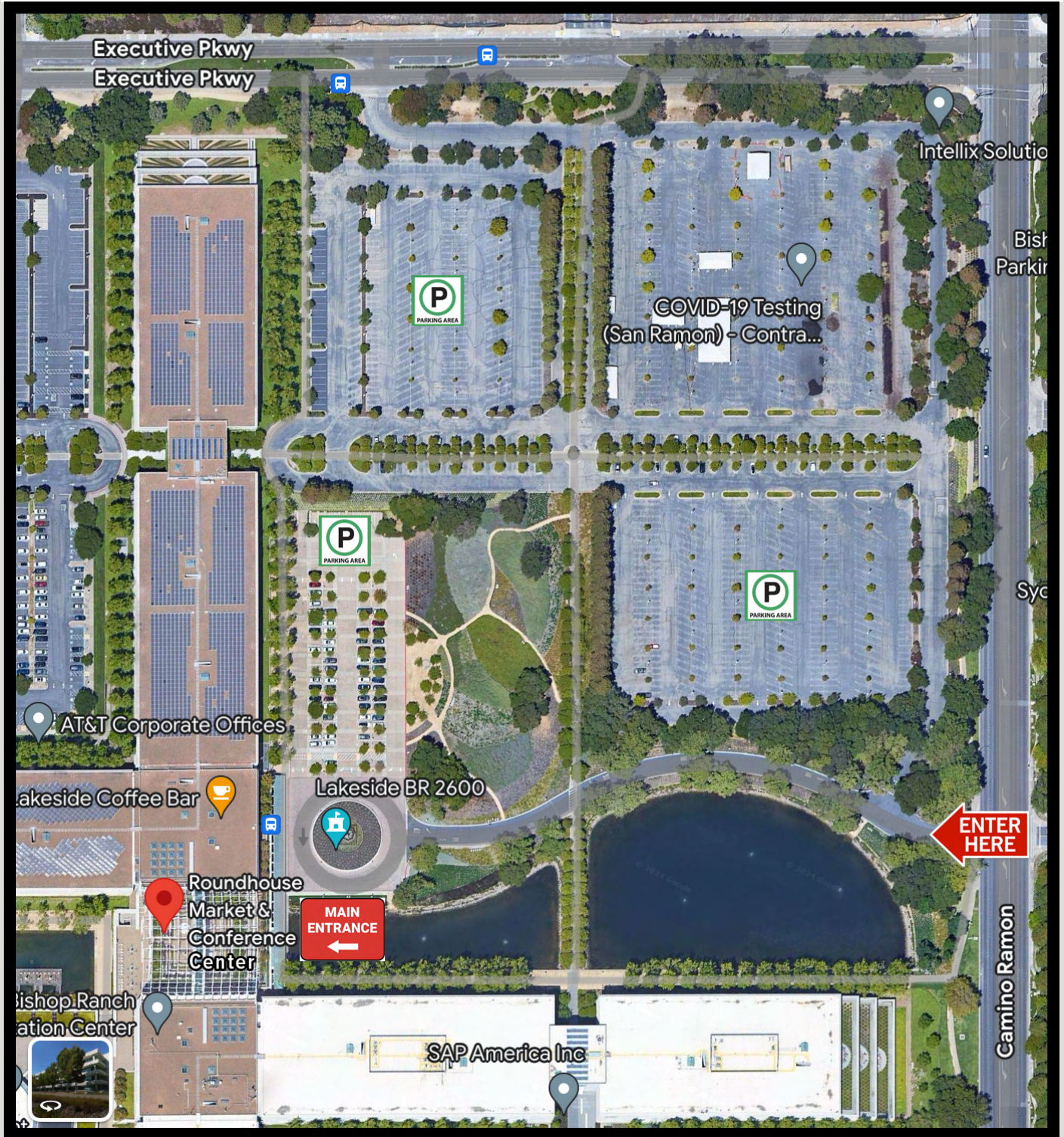

When can I expect exhibitor networking time?	The day includes networking with attendees during registration/check in beginning at 7:30am, morning break, lunch, and afternoon break. See attached agenda below.
Where is my table located?	All exhibitor tabletop displays will be situated in the foyer outside the Tahoe Auditorium. Your table will be assigned and clearly identified upon your arrival.
What is provided at my table and is there anything you suggest we bring?	Your allocated space measures approximately 8 feet wide by 5 feet deep and comes equipped with one 6-foot table, two chairs, electricity, and basic WiFi service. There will be room behind or beside the table for a small pop-up banner if you decide to bring one. While basic white table linens will be provided, you're welcome to bring your own branded table cover if preferred. Wall outlets will be conveniently situated near each exhibitor table to access electrical. We recommend bringing a small extension cable or power strip to ensure your electrical requirements are met.
How do I register for an exhibitor badge?	To be sure exhibitor badges are made in time for your arrival, please be sure to send the Name, Title, Cell Phone Number and Email of each representative attending the Summit via email to Heather Palka at hpalka@californiapolicechiefs.org by Tuesday 04/23/2024 . All exhibitor representatives must obtain and display an exhibitor badge at all times during the Summit.
How many badges are included with my table and can I add more?	Two (2) exhibitor badges are included with each exhibitor tabletop display purchased. You have the option to add up to one (1) additional exhibitor badge at the cost of \$500. However, please note that space behind the exhibitor tables is limited, as we can only accommodate 2 chairs behind each table. Additional attending representatives will likely need to occupy seats in the auditorium during the summit. Please notify Heather Palka if you wish to include additional representatives, and we will send an invoice accordingly.
How do I bring in my display materials?	Hand carry-in is the sole method for bringing in your display items and materials. This venue does not accept packages shipped to the site. Please plan on limiting items to self-transport and carry-in only. Please note that rolling carts are not available at this location, so please plan accordingly.
Is AV equipment allowed?	Any AV equipment needs will be the responsibility of the exhibiting company to bring from outside the facility. The Summit does not provide AV rentals. Please ensure any/all AV equipment fits on top of your designated tabletop display. If you have a more elaborate display, and require a different arrangement, please contact Heather Palka to see if accommodations can be made.
