



CPCA Report

2018 CA Legislature: *Voting Records*



The California Police Chiefs Association represents over 330 active municipal police chiefs whose primary mission is to provide safety for more than 26 million Californians. In furtherance of that mission, CPCA takes an extremely active role in the legislative process, specifically regarding policy with public safety implications. Due to the continuous efforts to reform our criminal justice system and the recent and alarming rise in violent crime, CPCA has decided to keep a record of the priority public safety legislation debated every year, and the vote record of the California Legislature. The following is a brief summary of the issues we raised for the top CPCA bills of 2018, and the subsequent voting record:

RED BILLS: CPCA Oppose

GREEN BILLS: CPCA Support

AB 748 (Ting): Requires law enforcement agencies to justify withholding the release of video or audio recordings of critical incidents beyond 45 days after the incident and every 30 days thereafter.

AB 1810 (Committee on Budget): Authorizes a pre-trial diversion program for individuals with mental health disorders alleged to have committed a misdemeanor or felony offense, including murder.

AB 2058 (Chau): Creates a separate category of DUID cannabis statute so law enforcement can track increases post-Proposition 64.

AB 2972 (Caballero): Prohibits peace officers from engaging in "motorcycle profiling" and creates a private right of action for individuals subjected to such profiling.

AB 3131 (Gloria): Requires local governments to consider law enforcement agencies use policies before acquiring or utilizing surplus military equipment offered through the 1033 program and requires an annual report on use.

SB 712 (Anderson): Allows for the use of license plate covers when parked in public spaces.

SB 1279 (Bradford): Artificially, caps sentencing for crimes such as domestic violence, molestation of a 14 or 15-year-old, fraud, sexual assault, and auto burglary at double the base term.

SB 1391 (Lara): Removes the court's ability to motion for a transfer of juveniles, 14 or 15 years of age, who are alleged to have committed a serious offense, to adult court.

SB 1392 (Mitchell): Eliminates the one-year sentence enhancement for each prior prison or county jail felony term.

SB 1393 (Mitchell): Makes the 5-year mandatory enhancement for repeat serious offenders discretionary.

SB 1421 (Skinner): Initially, CPCA was opposed to this measure; however, author amendments removed our concerns. This bill permits inspection of specified peace and custodial officer records pursuant to the California Public Records Act (CPRA).

SB 1437 (Skinner): Reduces penalties and accountability for those tried under the felony murder rule. This bill allows individuals previously sentenced on a theory of felony murder to petition for resentencing even if they plead guilty.

DATES for VOTES of RECORD

Most of the votes recorded reflect bills in their final state. However, several bills listed were amended significantly enough through the legislative process that CPCA removed its opposition and moved to a support position (SB 1421). Additionally, several bills did not make it far enough to be voted on by the second house (AB 2972, SB 712 and SB 1392). As such, the votes recorded were only at a time the bill was among CPCA priorities to oppose, or support. Below is a list of the date each vote was recorded, as well as whether the bill passed or failed:

AB 748 – Assembly (8-31-18); Senate (8-28-18)

- Passed Assembly (41 AYES, 32 NOES, 7 ABS); Passed Senate (24 AYES, 13 NOES, 3 ABS)

AB 1810 – Assembly (6-18-18); Senate (6-18-18)

- Passed Assembly (50 AYES, 25 NOES, 5 ABS); Passed Senate (24 AYES, 12 NOES, 2 ABS)

AB 2058 – Assembly (8-27-18); Senate (8-23-18)

- Passed Assembly (77 AYES, 1 NOES, 2 ABS); Passed Senate (38 AYES, 1 NOES, 1 ABS)

AB 2972 – Assembly ONLY (4-19-18)

- Passed Assembly (21 AYES, 28 NOES, 29 ABS); Not heard in Senate

AB 3131 – Assembly (8-30-18); Senate (8-29-18)

- Passed Assembly (42 AYES, 36 NOES, 2 ABS); Passed Senate (22 AYES, 16 NOES, 2 ABS)

SB 712 – Senate ONLY (1-30-18)

- Failed in Senate (12 AYES, 18 NOES, 10 ABS); Not heard in Assembly

SB 1279 – Assembly (8-31-18); Senate (5-30-18)

- Failed in Assembly (10 AYES, 50 NOES, 20 ABS); Passed Senate (22 AYES, 14 NOES, 3 ABS)

SB 1391 – Senate (8-30-18); Assembly (8-29-18)

- Passed Senate (23 AYES, 15 NOES, 2 ABS); Passed Assembly (41 AYES, 23 NOES, 16 ABS)

SB 1392 – Senate ONLY (5-31-18)

- Failed in Senate (18 AYES, 16 NOES, 5 ABS); Not heard in Assembly

SB 1393 – Assembly (8-31-18); Senate (5-14-18)

- Passed Assembly (41 AYES, 33 NOES, 6 ABS); Passed Senate (23 AYES, 14 NOES, 2 ABS)

SB 1421 – Assembly (8-31-18); Senate (8-31-18)

- Passed Assembly (44 AYES, 30 NOES, 6 ABS); Passed Senate (25 AYES, 11 NOES, 4 ABS)

SB 1437 – Senate (8-30-18); Assembly (8-29-18)

- Passed Senate (27 AYES, 10 NOES, 3 ABS); Passed Assembly (42 AYES, 36 NOES, 2 ABS)

BILLS VETOED: AB 2058, AB 3131
